**Priest** In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.  
*All* **Amen.**

**Priest** Alleluia! Christ is risen!  
*All* **He is risen indeed! Alleluia!**

¶ *Kyrie confession*

... Lord, have mercy. **Lord, have mercy.**

¶ *The Gloria follows the absolution.*

*All* **Glory to God in the highest, and peace to his people on earth.**

**Lord God, heavenly King, almighty God and Father, we worship you, we give you thanks, we praise you for your glory.**

**Lord Jesus Christ, only Son of the Father, Lord God, Lamb of God, you take away the sin of the world: have mercy on us; you are seated at the right hand of the Father: receive our prayer.**

**For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.**

¶ *Gospel reading.*

**Priest** Alleluia, alleluia. I am the first and the last, says the Lord, and the living one; I was dead, and behold I am alive for evermore.

*All* **Alleluia.**

The Lord be with you. **And also with you.**

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to *N.*

**Glory to you, O Lord.**

¶ *At the end of the Gospel:*

This is the Gospel of the Lord. **Praise to you O Christ.**

¶ *Affirmation of Faith*

**Priest** Do you believe and trust in God the Father,  
source of all being and life, the one for whom we exist?

*All* **We believe and trust in him.**

**Priest** Do you believe and trust in God the Son,  
who took our human nature, died for us and rose again?

*All* **We believe and trust in him.**

**Priest** Do you believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit,  
who gives life to the people of God  
and makes Christ known to the world?

*All* **We believe and trust in him.**

**Priest** This is the faith of the Church.

*All* **This is our faith. We believe and trust in one God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.**

¶ *Prayers of Intercession. These responses may be used:*

Lord in your mercy                      or                      Lord, hear us.  
*All*                      **Hear our prayer.**    **Lord, graciously hear us.**

¶ *At the end of the prayers, the following may be used:*

Merciful Father,  
*All*                      **Accept these prayers for the sake of your Son, our Saviour, Jesus Christ. Amen.**

**Priest** The risen Christ came and stood among his disciples and said,  
'Peace be with you.' Then were they glad when they saw the Lord.  
Alleluia. The peace of the Lord be always with you.

*All*                      **And also with you.**

¶ *Please do not share the peace with physical touch, or move closer to those around you. Please offer one another a sign of peace with a warm smile, nod or bow, and with the words 'peace be with you,' or similar.*

**Priest** Creator of all, you wash away our sins, you give us new birth by the Spirit, and redeem us in the blood of Christ. As we celebrate the resurrection, renew your gift of life within us. We ask this in the name of Jesus Christ the risen Lord. **Amen.**

¶ *The Eucharistic Prayer*

The Lord be with you. **And also with you.**  
Lift up your hearts. **We lift them to the Lord.**  
Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.  
**It is right to give thanks and praise.**

¶ *Sanctus and Benedictus, sung by the Cantor*

Holy, holy, holy Lord God of Hosts,  
heaven and earth are full of thy glory.  
Glory be to Thee O Lord most high.  
Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord.  
Hosanna in the highest.

¶ *During the Eucharistic Prayer*

Great is the mystery of faith:  
**Christ has died: Christ is risen: Christ will come again.**

¶ *The Lord's Prayer*

**Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name;  
thy kingdom come; thy will be done;  
on earth as it is in heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread.  
And forgive us our trespasses,  
as we forgive those who trespass against us.  
And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.  
For thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory,  
for ever and ever. Amen.**

¶ *The priest breaks the consecrated bread and says*

**Priest** We break this bread to share in the Body of Christ.

*All* **Though we are many, we are one body, because we all share in one bread.**

**Priest** Alleluia. Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us.

*All* **Therefore let us keep the feast. Alleluia.**

¶ *Agnus Dei, sung by the Cantor*

O Lamb of God, that takest away the sins of the world,  
have mercy upon us.

O Lamb of God, that takest away the sins of the world,  
have mercy upon us.

O Lamb of God, that takest away the sins of the world,  
grant us thy peace.

**Priest** Heavenly Father: as we participate with your people in these holy mysteries, we pray you now to grant to those who seek it your gift of spiritual communion, with trust in your faithfulness and your abiding love, through Jesus Christ Our Lord.

**Priest** The Body and Blood of Christ. **Amen.**

¶ *We receive the sacrament in one kind only. Please maintain social distancing as you come to receive the sacrament. Please do not speak. During the distribution the Cantor will sing a hymn.*

¶ *Following the post communion prayer we pray together:*

*All* **Almighty God, we thank you for feeding us with the body and blood of your Son Jesus Christ. Through him we offer you our souls and bodies to be a living sacrifice. Send us out in the power of your Spirit to live and work to your praise and glory. Amen.**

¶ *The Blessing and Dismissal*

... and the blessing of God almighty, the + Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, be among you and remain with you always. **Amen.**

**Priest** Go in the peace of Christ, alleluia, alleluia.

*All* **Thanks be to God. Alleluia. Alleluia.**

¶ *Please turn and face the Statue of Our Lady as the Regina Coeli is said.*

**Priest** Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia.

*All* **For the Lord is risen indeed, alleluia.**

¶ *Please respect social distancing and other current rules as you leave the church.*
