¶ *Prayers of Intercession.*

In the power of the Spirit let us pray to the Father through Christ the Saviour of the world.

Father, on this, the night he was betrayed, your Son Jesus Christ washed his disciples' feet. We commit ourselves to follow his example of love and service. Lord, hear us **and humble us.**

On this night, he prayed for his disciples to be one. We pray for the unity of your Church. Lord, hear us **and unite us.**

On this night, he prayed for those who were to believe through his disciples' message. We pray for the mission of your Church. Lord, hear us **and renew our zeal.**

On this night, he commanded his disciples to love, but suffered rejection himself. We pray for the rejected and unloved. Lord, hear us **and fill us with your love.**

On this night, he reminded his disciples that if the world hated them it hated him first. We pray for those who are persecuted for their faith. Lord, hear us **and give us your peace.**

On this night, he accepted the cup of death and looked forward to the new wine of the kingdom. We remember those who have died in the peace of Christ. Lord, hear us **and welcome all your children into paradise.**

Priest Jesus says: 'Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. Do not let your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.'

The peace of the Lord be always with you.

All **And also with you.**

¶ *Please do not share the peace with physical touch, or move closer to those around you. However, please offer one another a sign of peace with a warm smile, nod or bow, and with the words 'peace be with you,' 'the peace of the Lord,' or similar.*

¶ *Prayer at the preparation of the altar:*

At the eucharist we are with our crucified and risen Lord. We know that it is not only our ancestors, but we who were redeemed and brought forth from bondage to freedom, from mourning to feasting. We know that as he was with them in the upper room so our Lord is here with us now.

All **Until the kingdom of God comes let us celebrate this feast.**

Priest Heavenly Father: as we participate with your people in these holy mysteries, we pray you now to grant to those who seek it your gift of spiritual communion, with trust in your faithfulness and your abiding love, through Jesus Christ Our Lord.

Priest The Body and Blood of Christ.
All **Amen.**

¶ *We receive the sacrament in one kind only. Please maintain social distancing as you come to receive the sacrament. Please do not speak.*

¶ *The post communion prayer.*

Priest Lord Jesus Christ, we thank you that in this wonderful sacrament you have given us the memorial of your passion: grant us so to reverence the sacred mysteries of your body and blood that we may know within ourselves and show forth in our lives the fruit of your redemption, for you are alive and reign, now and for ever. **Amen.**

¶ *The **priest** dismisses the people with the words,*

Priest Go in peace to love and serve the Lord.
